Who is an Exceptional Family Member? What is the EFMP?

- ▶ An **Exceptional Family Member (EFM)** is the DEERS enrolled family member of a military member who requires special medical or educational services based on diagnosed physical, intellectual or emotional needs.
- ▶ The **Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)** can assist Marine Corps families in managing the dual demands of a Marine Corps career and the special needs of their child. Visit www.usmc-mccs-org/efmp to learn more about the EFMP.

You may be eligible for EFMP Respite Care if you are a Marine Corps Family and you:

- ▶ Have children residing at home,
- ▶ Are registered with EFMP on your base, and
- ▶ Are stationed at one of the following **Marine Corps Bases***:
 - MCB Camp Pendleton, CA
 - MCAS Miramar, CA
 - MCRD San Diego, CA
 - MCB Quantico, VA
 - Henderson Hall, VA
 - MCAS Beaufort, SC
 - MCRD Parris Island, SC
 - MCAS Cherry Point, NC
 - MCAS New River, NC
 - MCB Camp LeJeune, NC

There are no income restrictions; the service is free to eligible Marine Corps families.

How do I apply?

- ▶ Call **Child Care Aware®** at **1-800-424-2246** — Child Care Aware will connect you to a local Child Care Resource and Referral agency (CCR&R) to find your family local respite care child care services, **OR**
- ▶ Call your local USMC EFMP program — The EFMP Coordinator will refer you to your local CCR&R for respite care services. In all cases, the CCR&R:
 - works to provide respite care providers meeting your criteria;
 - contacts providers to find the type of child care of your choice; and
 - works with the provider to tailor the service to your child's need.
