Question 1: What is EFMP Respite Care?

Answer: EFMP Respite care is a program/benefit that provides temporary rest periods for family members who are responsible for the regular care of persons with special needs. Care may be provided in the EFM's home, the care providers' home or other settings.

Question 2: Are EFMP families from other military services eligible for the Marine EFMP Respite Care Program?

Answer: Yes, If EFMP families from other military services are attached to a Marine unit or otherwise supporting Marine deployment operations, they may qualify.

Question 3: Can EFMP respite care funds be used to provide child care for siblings of an EFM or child of an adult EFM?

Answer: Yes. The non-EFM sibling/child is eligible to receive services at the standard installation CDC rate.

Question 4: Can Marine Corps Child Development Center (CDC) programs be used for respite care?

Answer: Yes, for hourly and drop-in care only, as long as the family is enrolled and registered with the program.

Question 5: Are there any restrictions on who I can select as a respite care provider?

Answer: No. When using installation respite, you can select a provider (friend, neighbor, family member or professional) that you are familiar with and in a location that is convenient for you.
