ELIGIBILITY

Dependents enrolled in DEERS who require sub-specialty care on a regular basis and/or children who qualify for special education services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).



ENROLLMENT

- Contact the EFMP office for assistance
- Pick up or download the required enrollment forms:
 - DD 2792 Medical Summary
 - DD 2792-1 Special Education Summary
- When completed, return forms to EFMP office for processing

ASSIGNMENTS

The purpose of EFMP is to give consideration to the special needs of the family member during the assignment process and help minimize the disruption upon the family during relocation. During relocation, the EFMP assignment coordinators will research the new installation to ensure medical and education needs are accessible.
