

Health Care

The Naval Health Clinic, Quantico, is staffed and equipped to provide non-emergency ambulatory healthcare. Walk-in appointments and Emergency Services are not available. The clinic is open from 0730-1800 Monday through Friday. The clinic is closed on Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal Holidays.

All new patients are required to be registered in the Department of Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) and have a valid ID card if over 10 years old. Patients must also enroll with TRICARE and register in our computer system at the Medical Records Department (walk-in only) to ensure they are registered at our clinic. Proper registration enables you to make an appointment and/or receive prescriptions at the pharmacy. To make an appointment, leave a message for your provider or contact a nurse managed phone center 0730 -1600, Monday - Friday at 703-784-1725/1699 or toll-free at 888-784-1802, option 2.

For an emergency, go to the nearest emergency room or dial 911. Otherwise, contact TRICARE at 877-TRICARE to assist you in locating a provider. Once you have the name and address of a TRICARE authorized provider, contact your provider or your provider's designated representative through a nurse managed phone center at 703-784-1725, to receive a referral to seek out-of-area care. 

EFMP Welcome Aboard Guide

Welcome to Marine Corps Base Quantico!

The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is here to provide guidance on how to navigate through the Special Needs Process. Before arriving at Marine Corps Base (MCB) Quantico, we suggest you complete a Permanent Change of Station (PCS) needs assessment and forward it to the Quantico EFMP office. You can access a PCS needs assessment from your current EFMP office or via the Quantico EFMP website at www.quantico.usmc-mccs.org/EFMP.

The PCS needs assessment will be used by your Family Caseworker to begin to connect services such as base priority housing and accommodations (if eligible), medical, educational, respite care, and more.

Once you arrive at MCB Quantico, check into the EFMP office to meet your Family Caseworker and begin accessing services in the DC/Virginia Area.

Quantico Family Housing Office

- Make application for priority assignment to housing
 1. DD Form 1746
 2. Pet Disclosure Form
 3. Registered Sex Offender Form
 4. Copy of Orders
- Provide copy of your EFMP enrollment letter with requirements/modifications which determines type of home assigned
- Send qualifying paperwork minimum of 90 days prior to transfer
- Each military family will be offered one priority assignment per tour

Early Intervention Program

Educational and Developmental Intervention Services (EDIS) is an early intervention for children birth to 3 years of age, who live on MCB Quantico. Any parent can contact EDIS with any question or concern about their young child's development. For those infants and toddlers who have a delay in their development, EDIS provides an array of services in the home or in the child care setting. Infants born with certain medical conditions may also qualify for EDIS services. No referral is required and no cost is associated with this program. Child, Youth, & Teen Program (CYTP)

The Quantico CYTP provides care for children ages 6 weeks through 18 years of age, in a variety of settings, to include the Child Development Center, the Quantico Youth & Teen Center, and Family Child Care homes. Hourly care and full-time care are year round programs, while Part Day Preschool and School Age Care follow the school year calendar. Registration for all of these programs is completed at the Resource & Referral Office located at the Child Development Center (CDC) at 3311 Purvis Rd., 703-784-0674.

A child's special needs will be addressed by a Special Needs Evaluation Review Team (SNERT) prior to enrollment into CYTP.

School Liaison Office

The School Liaison Office, 703-784-4729, is also located at the CDC and offers educational services and transitional assistance for families with children in kindergarten through twelfth grade, who reside on and off base.

DoDEA Schools

Before you move, request from the current school to provide you with a copy of all your child's educational records, including the Individual Education Plan (IEP). Hand deliver records to the receiving school so that they have a clear understanding on how to serve your child. The receiving school will recognize your child's current IEP and comparable services will be provided until your child can be reassessed and eligibility can be determined based on DoDEA or local state standards.
