



MCBQ Pre-Separation/Transition Counseling

Pre-separation/Transition Counseling session is the starting point for formal transition process. Pre-separation/ Transition Counseling" is given to Service Members retiring, being discharged or released, and those who have served 180 continuous days or more on active duty in the Armed Forces in accordance with Title 10, U.S. Code, Chapter 58, Section 1142. This counseling will be a brief overview and explanation of benefits, services, programs and resources required under Pre-separation/Transition Counseling and documented using the electronic DD Form 2648.

Retirees may register and complete the Pre-Separation Counseling 24 months prior to RETIREMENT. Separates may register and complete the Pre-Separation Counseling 18 months prior to SEPARATION. In the case of special circumstances, the process should be started as soon as possible.
